Dear Supporters, Ambassadors, and Allies,

What a year it has been in 2020, for everyone! However this year has looked for you and your family, please know that our hearts are with you. You are so important to our mission, and more than ever we could not do this work without your "Yes!"

Like everyone else, we could not have planned for the challenges a year like this one would hold. In March, we made the difficult but necessary decision to prioritize the safety of our staff, volunteers, and the women we serve. We had tremendous concerns about what making nearly all our programs virtual would mean for the women we invest in through Created Care and Outreach. Would we see an increase in relapse and a return to dangerous people and situations? Would women separate from community all together? Would there be less opportunity for us to love and support women in the ways they needed?

During the first few months, a shock wave rushed over many in our program as we adjusted to community time looking very different and everything taking more effort and planning. But, like always, resiliency and hope won, and the impossible was made possible!

I have never been more proud of our staff, community, and the women we serve. Victims became survivors. Participants became leaders. Our nonprofit continued to thrive, meeting emergency needs, responding to a record number of referrals, and adding more support staff. At such a time as this, we knew it could only be the hand of God on us and our ministry. Being virtual allowed for more women to gain access to our services, and Created Gainesville became a welcome place for survivors across the state and even out of state.










From a record-breaking response at Life Reclaimed \$350,000.00 2020 to more churches, organizations and individuals supporting our mission than ever before, we are so thankful for the outpouring \$250,000.00 of support we have received this year.

FROM THE BOARD

The most recent memory I have of a crowded room is Created's Life Reclaimed annual dinner this past February. It was crowded because ministry partners like you continue to believe in our mission to reach and restore lives impacted by sex trafficking and sexual exploitation. It was crowded because ministry partners like you continue to give generously to make the mission happen. Most importantly, it was crowded because God graciously allowed us to gather for the dinner right before shutdowns and cancellations became part of our lives.



It turns out that the dinner was just the beginning of God's faithfulness to Created in 2020. Though many of our ministry rhythms have changed (anyone heard of Zoom?), God has given us countless opportunities to reach women in need of help and healing. We've stepped in to sponsor rent and utility payments for women facing sudden job loss. We've responded to more referrals from individuals, service organizations, and law enforcement partners than ever before (50 and counting!). And as we wrap up our eighth year of ministry, I'm glad to report that Created has now reached approximately 2.500 women.

But perhaps the greatest sign of God's faithfulness is the work he's done this past year to perfectly position us for a huge next step in 2021. What is that next step? I'm not supposed to say TOO much, but I will tell you that the tagline for this year's Life Reclaimed dinner is "Inviting Her Home". I can also tell you that, more than ever, we'll need your prayers and generosity.

I'm so thankful for you, and I can't wait to see what God does through Created in the coming year!
